CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ARTHUR W. PATTERSON, successor in interest to George A. Woodcock,

of Rogue River, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of domestic, stock and irrigation of 16.0 acres and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1902;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.27 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

16.0 acres in that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ lying East of Evans Creek of which 2.5 acres lie above the ditch and are irrigated by pumping therefrom
Section 9,
T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

This certificate also confirms a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered October 23, 1963 and recorded at page 55, Volume 13, Special Order Record pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
