CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FLOSSIE REXFORD CARL,

of Murphy, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
domestic and irrigation 8.5 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from October, 1898;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 17, T. 38 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

8.5 acres in that part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 7,
T. 38 S., R. 4 W., W.M.
described as follows:

Commencing at the SW corner of a 10-acre tract of land owned by E. U. Provolt,
in Section 7, T. 38 S., R. 4 W., W.M., Jackson County, Oregon, running thence
South 40 rods; thence East to the county road; thence Northerly along the East
line of said public road to the SE corner of the above-described 10 acres of
land owned by said E. U. Provolt; thence West to the place of beginning, con-
taining 10 acres, more or less.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
