## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That RUFUS A. GILMORE,

of Murphy, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 13.0 acres  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from February, 1899;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic foot per  
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 21, T. 37 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

4.0 acres in that part of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 18,  
described as follows:

Beginning at the SE corner of Section 18, T. 37 S., R. 5 W., W.M.; running thence  
West 80 rods; thence North 20 rods; thence East 80 rods to the section line; thence  
South 20 rods to beginning.

9.0 acres in Lot 2 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Section 19,  
T. 37 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

This certificate also confirms a change in point of diversion approved by an  
order of the State Engineer entered April 19, 1948 and recorded at page 18,  
Volume 6, Special Order Record pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
