confirmed dates from February, 1892;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.52 cubic feet per second.

The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NE4. Section 1. T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
