## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That MURPHY ELECTRIC IRRIG. INC., successor in interest to Ella A. Snively,

of Murphy, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 11.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from February, 1899;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 21, T. 37 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 18,  
T. 37 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

being within the following-described tract:

Beginning at a point 30 rods North of the center of Sec. 18, T. 37 S., R. 5 W., W.M.; thence East 80 rods to the East line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said section; thence South 30 rods; thence West 80 rods to the center of said Sec. 18; thence North to the place of beginning.

This certificate also confirms a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered April 19, 1948 and recorded at page 18, Volume 6, Special Order Record pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
