CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. R. and ALICE L. LINDSAY,

of R.F.D. No. 2, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 1.5 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from February, 1899;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.5 acres in that part of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
lying below the Wilderville Ditch
Section 7,
T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W.M.
being within the following-described
tract:

Beginning at the NW corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W.M., in Josephine County, Oregon, and running thence South 229 feet; thence East 420 feet; thence North 88.75 feet; thence East 450 feet; thence North 140.25 feet to the North line of said legal subdivision; thence West 870 feet to the place of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
