## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** J. R. and ALICE LINDSAY and DELMER L. TERRY,  
successors in interest to James P. Ward,

of R.F.D. No. 2, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 20.0 acres  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from February, 1899;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.40 cubic foot per  
second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 15, T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

20.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 7,

less and excepting those certain parcels of real estate conveyed to the Beaver  
Portland Cement Company for railroad right of way purposes, said parcel of land  
being more particularly described in Volume 55, Deed Records, at Pages 436-7 and  
in Volume 56, Deed Records, at Page 415, Records of Josephine County, Oregon,  
said excepted parcel containing approximately 1.5 acres; also less and excepting  
a tract of land conveyed to J. R. Lindsay and Alice Lindsay, being more particularly  
described as follows:

Beginning at the NW corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, and running thence South  
229 feet; thence East 420 feet; thence North 88.75 feet; thence East 450 feet;  
thence North 140.25 feet to the North line of said legal subdivision; thence  
West 870 feet to the place of beginning, containing about 3.25 acres also; less  
and excepting the right of way of the county road across said described premises.  
Also subject to an easement for a roadway 20 feet in width granted to the said  
J. R. Lindsay and Alice Lindsay extending from the South line of the tract  
conveyed to said Lindsays to the county road as described in conveyance recorded  
in Volume 63, at Page 163, Deed Records of Josephine County, Oregon.

This certificate as issued confirms the remaining part of the water right  
not canceled by order of the State Engineer entered February 21, 1964 and  
recorded at page 230, Volume 13, Special Order Record pursuant to the provisions  
of ORS 540.610 to 540.650.
