R. Lindsay and Alice Lindsay, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the NW corner of the SEL NEW of Section 7, and running thence South 229 feet; thence East 420 feet; thence North 88.75 feet; thence East 450 feet; thence North 140.25 feet to the North line of said legal subdivision; thence West 870 feet to the place of beginning, containing about 3.25 acres also; less and excepting the right of way of the county road across said described premises.
