CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EVERETT E. ROBINSON, successor in interest
to N. A. McLeod,

of 100 Redland Drive, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
irrigation of 16.3 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from February, 1899;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

16.3 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 6,
T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W.M.

This certificate also confirms a change in place of use approved by an
order of the State Engineer entered November 20, 1944 and recorded at page 532,
Volume 4, Special Order Record pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to
540.530.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
