## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** CALVIN and V. A. RICHARDSON, successors in interest to V. Richardson,

of Route 4, Box 387, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Williams Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 9.2 acres and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from June, 1890;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 1, T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.2 acres within that part of NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>  
Section 1,  
T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W.M.  
described as follows:

All of said NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> except a strip off the North side 346 feet wide and a strip off the West side 234 feet wide.

This certificate also confirms a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered July 11, 1957 and recorded at page 178, Volume 9, Special Order Record pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
