## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That CLIFF B. BENTLEY, successor in interest to  
A. J. Smith,

of P.O. Box 53, Williams, Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of West Fork Williams Creek

a tributary of Williams Creek for the purpose of  
irrigation of 3.6 acres  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from December, 1908;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.094 cubic foot per  
second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 35, T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

3.6 acres in SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>  
Section 35,  
T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

This certificate confirms a change in place of use and point of diversion  
approved by an order of the State Engineer entered July 13, 1962 and recorded  
at page 77, Volume 12, Special Order Record pursuant to the provisions of  
ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
