## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** CLAIR O. BROWN,

of Williams, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of Cherry Gulch

a tributary of Williams Creek for the purpose of  
irrigation of 7.1 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from May 6, 1905;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per  
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 2, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

7.1 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 2,  
T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
