CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **WARREN D. MEE,**

of Applegate, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Thompson Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of
irrigation of 6.4 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1903;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, T. 39 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

6.4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 28,
T. 38 S., R. 4 W., W.M.
being within the following-described
tract:

Beginning at the NE corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 28; thence South 9 rods to
the upper bank of the Hinkle Ditch; thence Southwesterly along said upper bank
78 rods; thence Northwesterly 31 rods to a laurel tree at the county road; thence
along the county road Northeasterly 31 rods to the South line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of
said section; thence East 65 rods to the place of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
