CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MATTIE M. PATTON,

of Leland, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Grave Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
irrigation of 4.0 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1908;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, T. 34 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

4.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 8,
T. 34 S., R. 5 W., W.M.
lying below the Browning Ditch in that
part of the following described property:

Commencing 7.72 chains West of the NE corner of Sec. 8, T. 34 S., R. 5 W., W.M.;
thence South 16° West 20.75 chains; thence West 6.50 chains; thence South about
120 feet to a point 30 feet East of the NE corner of the town of Placer; thence
West 30 feet to the NE corner of the town of Placer; thence South 78° West 460
feet to the NE corner of Lot 2, in Block 5, town of Placer; thence North 12°
West 700 feet; thence South 48-3/4° West 705 feet; thence North to the North
line of Sec. 8; thence East to beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
