that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NEL SEL Section 12. T. 34 S., R. 6 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.7 acre in that part of SW¹ NW¹ Section 12.
T. 34 S., R. 6 W., W.M. described as follows:

Beginning at a point 250 feet East of the NW corner of $SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$, Sec. 12, T. 34 S.. R. 6 W., W.M.; thence running South 1320 feet to the East and West subdivision line through the center of said Sec. 12; thence East 250 feet; thence Northeasterly 1480 feet to a point which is 900 feet East of the point of beginning; thence West 900 feet to the point of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
