CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That H. G. CHAPMAN,

of 229 West 15th Street, Long Beach, State of California, has a right to the use of the waters of Grave Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 1.6 acres and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1908;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, T. 34 S., R. 6 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.6 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 11,

1.0 acre in that part of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 12,
T. 34 S., R. 6 W., W.M.

described as follows:

Commencing at a point from which the N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Sec. 11, T. 34 S., R. 6 W., W.M., bears North 41° 17' West 9.677 chains; thence South 58° 25' East 1549.4 feet to the point of beginning; thence South 62° 53' East 1320 feet; thence north 628.5 feet; thence North 62° 53' West 1320 feet; thence South 628.5 feet to the point of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
