CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JEFFERSON and MARY WIMER,

of Leland, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Grave Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
irrigation of 11.1 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1908;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, T. 34 S., R. 6 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

11.1 acres in that part of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 12,
T. 34 S., R. 6 W., W.M.
being within the following-described
tract:

Beginning at a point on the West line of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 12, a distance of 64 rods
North of the SW corner of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence North 67° West 1400 feet; thence
North 27° 55' East 33 rods; thence in a Northeasterly direction to the NE corner
of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, said Sec. 12; thence South along the East line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ to the
point of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
