CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify. That H. R. INKS

of Bandon , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring Creek

a tributary of Coquille River irrigation of cranberries

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 17596 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 7, 1917

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.038 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE_4^1 NE_2^1 , Section 20, T. 28 S., R. II W., W. M. Diversion point located 980 feet South and 1700 feet East from the N_4^1 Corner, Section 20

Section 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-tenth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.75 acre foot for each acre irrigated in any 30-day period and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 6 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.038 cubic foot per second,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.5h acres SE4 SW4 Section 17 T. 28 S., R. Lh W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of the property described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the NW of Section 17, T. 28 S., R. lh W., W. M., Coos County, Oregon, thence North 633.0 feet; thence West 466.0 feet; thence South 633.0 feet; thence East 466.0 feet to the place of beginning.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered September 5, 1960, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to H. R. Inks and recorded at page 21652, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
