CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify. That CHARLES R. BRIGGS

of Box 156, Umpqua , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Hubbard Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of h.l acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 273\(\frac{18}{48}\) of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from \(\text{April}\) 20, \(\frac{1961}{2}\).

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE_4 SE_4 , Section 36, T. 25 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water shall be limited to the period when the flow of the Umpqua River is more than 525 c.f.s. at tidewater,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

O.1 acre Lot h (SW SW SW Section 31 T. 25 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

h.O acres SE4 SE4 Section 36 T. 25 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Charles R. Briggs and recorded at page 309k7, Volume 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 6.1 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion appurtenant to the irrigation of 2.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered December 20, 1965. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Charles R. Briggs.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
