## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **NYE AND ALLENBY**

of **35 Whistler's Lane, Roseburg**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **North Umpqua River**

a tributary of **Umpqua River** for the purpose of irrigation of **20.95 acres**

under Permit No. **24551** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **October 3, 1956**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.194 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )**, Section 16, T. 26 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet** per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

 1.4 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Dailey DLC 46  
 1.8 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Dailey DLC 46  
 0.8 acre Lot 9 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ )

Certificate of water right issued to Nye and Allenby and recorded at page 28559, Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 35.7 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion appurtenant to the irrigation of 14.75 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered December 27, 1965. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Nye and Allenby. ~~The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.~~
