

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify. That 150 L. AND CLARA C. FLOWER

of Kimberly , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Fork of John Day River

a tributary of John Day River irrigation of 66.7 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 23868 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 30, 1955

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.85 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $SW_{\frac{1}{4}}$ $NW_{\frac{1}{4}}$, Section 2, T. 9 S., R. 27 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre Lot 2 (NW4 NE4)
16.8 acres SW4 NE4
2.1 acres Lot 3 (NE4 NW4)
14.2 acres SW4 NW4
25.6 acres SE4 NW4
7.5 acres NE4 SW4
Section 2
T. 9 S., R. 27 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Leo L. and Clara C. Flower and recorded at page 29969, Volume 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 104.5 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion appurtenant to the irrigation of 37.8 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered January 11, 1966. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Leo L. and Clara C. Flower.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
