CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. H. MCNABB

of 547 Calle Abronia, Apt. 2, Palm Springs, State of California, has a right to the use of the waters of Bear Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
 irrigation of 13 acres, and domestic use
 and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
 the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
 confirmed dates from 1860

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per
 second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, T. 38 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 4.5 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 31
 8.5 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 32
 T. 38 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered November 29, 1965, and to locate the place of use as provided by the decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County entered October 2, 1964, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to W. T. Bostwick and recorded at page 15894, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
