## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOSEPHINE COUNTY

of Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of McMullen Creek

a tributary of Deer Creek for the purpose of  
maintenance of Lake Selmac for recreational purposes (Lake Selmac Dam \*See Below  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 13, at page 70; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from August 22, 1902;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.87 cubic foot per  
second and shall be limited to the period between April 1 and November 1 of each  
year.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 18, T. 38 S., R. 7 W., W. M.  
Diversion point located 320 feet North and 380 feet West from the SE Corner +(see below)  
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use and change  
in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered December  
29, 1965, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to M. N.  
Loughridge and recorded at page 13888, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right  
Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
