CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GLAE C. GOULD

of P. O. Box 443, North Bend , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Millicoma River and an unnamed stream

a tributary of Coos River irrigation of 14.2 acres and domestic use for camp site

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 28399 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 21, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.185 cubic foot per second, being 0.18 c.f.s. from Millicoma River for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. from unnamed stream for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the River: NE1 NW1 and NE1 SW1; Unnamed stream:

SE2 NW2; Section 26, T. 23 S., R. 11 W., W. M. Diversion points located: River

340 feet South and 280 feet West, 2800 feet South and 770 feet West; *(see below)

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other

right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second

per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited

to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated

during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.5 acres NF4 W4 Domestic and 6.1 acres SE4 W4 5.6 acres NE4 SW4 Section 26 T. 23 S., R. 11 W., W. M.

* Unnamed stream 2090 feet South and 310 feet West; all from the N_4^1 Corner, Section 26.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
