## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That LLOYD NICHOLSON

of Box 31, Fort Klamath , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Crooked Creek

a tributary of irrigation (Supplemental) of 111.7 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 29078 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 3, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.84 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NN¼ NE½, Section 26, T. 33 S., R. 7½ E., W. M. Diversion point located 1200 feet South and 270 feet East from the North ¼ corner of Section 26.

The amount of water used for ligation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for a chacre irrigated during the period of July 20 to October 1 of each year and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet during said period,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
