CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WAYNE D. RANSOM & THERESA E. RANSOM

of 4408 Barbara Way N.E., Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of 3 springs

a tributary of Alsea River for the purpose of domestic use of 11 families

under Permit No. 23284 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 19, 1954

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. from spring No. 1 and 0.01 c.f.s. from spring No. 2 and 0.01 c.f.s. from spring No. 3

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 9 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and Lot 8 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 32, T. 13 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6 families Lot 9 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
5 families Lot 8 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 32
T. 13 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
