CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under State Engineer's permits)

This is to Certify, That S. A. McCUNE, ADA R. HICKS, H. N. HAMMOND, W. S. HAMMOND and H. B. HAMMOND, c/o S. A. McCUNE of Ashland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Glade Creek, a branch of Williams Creek, a tributary of Applegate River, for the purpose of the irrigation of 180 acres of land and domestic use under Permit No. 2693 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 397, on the 23rd day of May, 1921; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 27, 1915; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.25 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 20 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Three; 35 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter and 10 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Ten; 14 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter, 16 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 20 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Fifteen, Township Thirty-nine South, Range Five West of Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon.

The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre for each acre irrigated, or its equivalent in case of rotation; balance for domestic use. The use for irrigation purposes shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
