CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. R. WILLIS and CORA W. WILLIS

of 780 S. E. 13th Avenue, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under application No. R-37895, permit No. R-3090, a tributary of Nehalem River for the purpose of domestic use of one family and fish culture

under Permit No. 28238 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 2, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use from unnamed stream and 0.01 c.f.s. for fish culture from unnamed stream and reservoir, provided further that the right to use of direct flow for fish culture *See Below or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 8, T. 4 N., R. 7 W., W. M. Diversion point for stream located 1820 feet South and 540 feet East from NW Corner, Section 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 8
T. 4 N., R. 7 W., W. M.

* is limited to the period when the flow of the Nehalem River is more than 100 c.f.s. at USGS Gage No. 14-3010.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
