CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

of 2600 State Street, Salem 10, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Walker Creek (infiltration well adjacent to the stream)

a tributary of Nehalem River for the purpose of domestic, including irrigation of not to exceed $\frac{1}{4}$ acre lawn and garden at State Forestry Jewell Side Camp under Permit No. 28754 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 9, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, T. 5 N., R. 7 W., W. M. Diversion point located 2470 feet South and 817.8 feet East from the North $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of Section 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Further described as follows:

Beginning at the center of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 7 W., W. M., which is marked by a steel automobile axle; thence N. 0° 30' E., 1320.0 ft., thence East 745.8' to the West right of way line of the Beneke Creek Road; thence S. 17° 30' W., 1070.5 ft. along said right of way line; thence S. 7° E., 301.6 ft. continuing along said right of way line; thence W. 449.0 ft. to the point of beginning, being that part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 7 W., W. M., lying west of the Beneke Creek Road, consisting of 16.35 acre more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
