## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is To Certify, That ROBERT F. AND JEAN M. LEPSCHAT

ofRoute 1, Box 30, Forest Grove , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

a tributary of Willamette River

for the purpose of

irrigation of 7.0 acres under Permit No. 17503 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 11, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.088 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SW_4^1$   $SE_4^1$ , as projected within R. F. Tupper DLC No. 42, Section 13, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion point located 750 feet West and 950 feet North from the SE Corner DLC 42.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to pne-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.7 acres SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>
l.3 acres SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>
both as projected within R. F. Tupper DLC 42

1.0 acre NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>
as projected within R. F. Tupper DLC 42
Section 2h
T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Lying in the SE cor. of the Robert F. Tupper EIC in Sections 13 and 24, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M., and E. of the Tualatin River and more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point in the center of said River on the S. side of said Tupper Claim in Sec. 24, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M., and running thence E. 25 chs. to the SE cor. of said Claim on the W. line of the W. O. Gibson Claim, thence N. 23° 15' W. on the W. line of said Gibson Claim to the center of the said Tualatin R., thence up the channel of said river to the place of beginning. Subject to rights of way for telephone line, public roads and highways, as same may now exist over and across said lands.

This certificate is issued so as to correctly show the location of place of use and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Mrs. Virginia Bridges and recorded at page 2026h, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
