CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROBERT W. ROARK, JOY V. MARTIN, C. L. ALRIGHT,
GEORGE C. STURSA

of 3445 Granite Hill Road, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Louse Creek

a tributary of Jump-Off-Joe Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 4.2 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1896;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.084 cubic foot per
second

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, T. 35 S., R. 5 W.,
W. M. Diversion points located: Roark - 560 feet East and 120 feet South; *See Below
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

Certificate of water right issued to Nathan Merritt and recorded at page 16508,
Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use
of water for irrigation of 6.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of
water appurtenant to 1.8 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered
May 2, 1966. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the
use of water for irrigation and to confirm a change in place of use and point
of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered September 3, 1963,
and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Nathan Merritt.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
