CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That V. C. COLE

of **Beaver**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Foland Creek**

a tributary of **Nestucca River** for the purpose of irrigation of **17½ acres**

under Permit No. **279** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **April 12, 1910**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.22 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.9 acres SE¼ SE¼

3.4 acres NE¼ NE¼

7.4 acres NW¼ NW¼

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by orders of the State Engineer entered June 13, 1927 and June 22, 1965, and supercedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to H. S. Davidson and recorded at page 740, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
