CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CABAX MILLSof Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of East Fork Illinois Rivera tributary of _____ for the purpose of
manufacturing and maintenance of log pond
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 13, at page 70; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from May, 1887;that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.28 cubic foot per
second during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year.The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, T. 39 S., R. 8 W., W. M.A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

T. 39 S., R. 8 W., W.M.This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use of water approved by an
order of the State Engineer entered April 16, 1964, and together with the certi-
ficates recorded at pages 31667 and 31668, Volume 23, supersedes certificates
of water right heretofore issued to Ed Burke and E. W. Wright and recorded at
pages 13839 and 13953, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates.And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
