## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is To Certify, That CARL H. KREDER, JR.

of Route 2, Box 292, Dayton , State of Oregon 97114 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Yamhill River a tributary of

for the purpose of

irrigation of 17.9 acres under Permit No. 14865 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 14, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1 NW 1 as projected within Hanna DIC 14, Section 17, T. 4 S., R. 3 W., W. M. Diversion point located 50 feet East from the SW Corner DIC 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Commoncing at a stone at the N.E. corner of that tract of land conveyed by deed from A. P. Kempton and Helen Kempton his wife to Louis Howarth and Anna C. Howarth, his wife and recorded in Book 62, page 340 deed records of Yamhill County, Oregon and running thence S. 27° W. along the Easterly line of aforesaid Howarth tract, said line being also the Easterly line of the Franklin Martin DLC #45, a distance of 2007 feet to a point on the North Bank of the Yamhill River which is the S. E. corner and true beginning point of the Land herein described; Running thence from said true beginning point N. 27° 3. 908.55 feet to an iron pipe which is S. 27° W. 1098.45 feet from the N.E. corner of the before mentioned Howarth tract; Running thence from said iron pipe Westerly 1768.8 feet to a point in the Westerly line of hereinbefore mentioned Howarth tract at a point which is Southerly 798 feet from a stone
