CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That PEARL CHADWICK, of Union, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of MILL CREEK, a tributary of Catherine Creek and the Grande Ronde River, in Union County, Oregon, which said right consists of the use of the waste waters from Calawell and Selders ditches and Duncan Branch,

for the purpose of irrigation from May 15th to September 15th of each year;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 207 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1898;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed .09 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

7 a. in SW 1/4 Sec. 15, Tp. 3 S. R. 40 E. W. M., in Union County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
