CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILBUR H. DAY and AGNES H. DAY
dba Roads End Water System
of P. O. Box 450, Wecoma Beach, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Logan Creek

a tributary of Supplemental group domestic for the purpose of

under Permit No. 27408 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from May 22, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the Lot 5 (E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 35, T. 6 S., R. 11 W.,
W. M. Diversion point located South 65' 11" East 2634.8 feet from the NW corner
Section 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:
