CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WERNER J. & PATRICIA A. DONAT

of P. O. Box 5293, Carmel, State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed gulch and Skou Reservoir constructed under permit No. R-1744

a tributary of Snider Creek, (Rogue River) for the purpose of irrigation of 7.0 acres

under Permit No. 27208 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 16, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 26, T. 35 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Diversion point located 890 feet North and 70 feet East from the SW corner of Section 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit No. R-1744, provided further that the right to the use of direct flow is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 1000 c.f.s. at Raygold, more than 1000 c.f.s. immediately above Savage Rapids Dam and more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.8 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
2.2 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 27
T. 35 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
