CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CURTICE MARTIN

of Mount Vernon , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Caurse Well No. 1

a tributary of Birch Creek, (John Day River) supplemental irrigation of 66.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-2356 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 13, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.83 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1_4 SW 1_4 , Section 22, T. 13 S., R. 29 E., W. M. Well located 1800 feet North and 420 feet East from the SW Corner of SE 1_4 SW 1_4 , Section 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

13.4 acres NE 3 SW 11.2 acres NW 5 SW 19.2 acres SW 5 SW 20.0 acres SE 5 SW Section 22

2.8 acres NE 1 NW 1 Section 27
T. 13 S., R. 29 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
