This Is to Certify, That THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
 REPRESENTED BY THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS

of 628 Pittcock Block, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Zumwalt Park Well

a tributary of Fern Ridge, reservoir on the Long Tom River, trib. for the purpose of operation and maintenance of Public Park (Willamette R.)

under Permit No. G-1801 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 23, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Levi Zumwalt DLC 52, Section 28, T. 17 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Well located 1635 feet South and 510 feet East from the NW corner of Section 28

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
