a tributary of Unnamed atream (Pudding River) irrigation of 30.0 acres

for the purpose of

G-2196 under Permit No. of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right kereby confirmed dates from April 27, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE4 NW4, as projected within G. Settlemire DLC 53, Section 9, T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Well located 1180 feet West and 1370 feet North from the SE Corner DLC 53.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each a cre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 6.4 acres SW NE 4.9 acres SE4 NV4 6.2 acres NE4 SW4 12.5 acres NW4 SE4 all as projected within G. Settlemire DLC 53 Section 9 T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
