This Is To Certify, That CASCADE RANCHES, INC.

, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
two springs, four unmaned streams, west forks Lake Creek and reservoir constructed
under Application No. R-25358, Permit No. R-1081

a tributary of Lake Creek

for the purpose of

irrigation of 105.9 acres under Permit No. 1982 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 9, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.32 cubic feet per second; being 0.01 c.f.s. from Spring No. 1; 0.09 c.f.s. from Spring No. 2; 0.20 c.f.s. from each of four unnamed streams, and 0.21 c.f.s. from each of two branches of West Forks Lake Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NN1 SE1, SE1 SE1, Section 12, T. 37 S., R. 1 E., W. M. NE1 NN1, Section 7, SE1 SN1, Section 18, T. 37 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed liz acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31, of each year; from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1081;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
