29346 under Permit No. of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 18, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 NW4, as projected within Anderson DLC 117, Section 19, T. 27 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Diversion point located 110 feet South and 2500 feet West from 130 NW Corner, Willis DLC 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other

right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ---- of one cubic foot per second ner acre.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE NE as projected within Morgan DIC 50 Section 24 T. 27 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to use of direct flow shall be limited to the period when the flow of the South Umpqua River is more than 60 c.f.s. at its mouth.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
