CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RICHARD C. STRATFORD, TRUSTEE
c/o J. E. Snodgrass,
of P. O. Box 1088, Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
North Fork Desch Creek and reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1918

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of
log storage

under Permit No. 29347 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from November 18, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.75 cubic foot per second, and shall be further limited to the deficiency in the
available supply in Livingston Creek under a prior right for the same purpose;
The right to use of direct flow is limited to the period when the flow of the
South Umpqua River is more than 60 c.f.s. at its mouth;
or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Anderson DIC 47,
Section 19, T. 27 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion point located 140 feet South and
2500 feet West from NW Corner, Willis DIC 45.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:
