Certificate of water right issued to Vida and Clarence Rankin and recorded at page 32722, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 146.6 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 40.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer Entered August 31, 1966. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Vida and Clarence Rankin.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
