## ERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

M. F. HANLEY

Oregon Lake Creek , State of , has a right to the use of the waters of Wasson Canyon for Tract No. 1; Long Canyon for Tract No. 2 and North Fork of Little Butte Creek for Tracts No. 3, 4, and 5 for the purpose of

irrigation of 994.5 acres, domestic and stock and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11 , at page 198; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1856 for Tract No. 1; 1879 for Tract No. 2; 1881 for Tract No. 3; 1903 for Tract No. 1; and April, 1907 for Tract No. 5;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.25 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 1; 1.5 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 2; 5.13 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 3; 2.24 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 4 and 6.5 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 5.

The point of diversion is located in the NET SET, Section 26, T. 36 S., R. 2 E., W. M.; being 1498 feet North and 420 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 26, \* A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as

The water used for the aforesaid purposes shall be measured at the head of the ditch or the point where the same leaves the natural stream, from April 1st to October 1st of each year;

Certificate of water right issued to M. F. Hanley and recorded at page 17185, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 1019.5 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 25.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered November 25, 1966. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to M. F. Hanley.

(Note: Certain lands in Sections 23 and 26 have supplemental rights from Wasson Canyon as listed above under date of 1856.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
