that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.73 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW2 SW2, as projected within J. Shaw DLC u6, Section 22, T. 3 S., R. 5 W., W. M.; being 1500 feet North and 125 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 22, T. 3 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed and to which such rights.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered August 11, 1964, and to correctly show the lands irrigated, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Fred C. Morley and recorded at page 5567, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
