CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

BERT G. HARR

of Route 1, Box 23 M, Jacksonville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River and Carberry Fork

a tributary of Rogue River irrigation of 3.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 4513 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 25, 1920

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed O.O. cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW1 NE1, Section 10, T. 41 S., R. 4 W., W. M. being 1520 feet South and 1710 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 10, T. 41 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.0 acres NE 1 N 2 Section 2 T. 41 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Bert G. Harr and recorded at page 5309, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 9.5 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 6.5 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered May 13, 1966. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Bert G. Harr.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
