## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

Oregon , has made proof of Route 3, Box 171, Medford , State of to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigation of 55.4 acres

for the purpose of

of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 298 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 26, 1909

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.29 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rolation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (Nu SE1), Section 17, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to B. L. Dodge and recorded at page 27130, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 381.4 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 326.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered October 28, 1966. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to B. L. Dodge.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
