**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** UNITED STATES OF AMERICA  
BY: U.S. ARMY ENGINEER DISTRICT, SEATTLE

of 1519 Alaskan Way South, Seattle, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Well No. 4

a tributary of Umatilla River (Columbia River) for the purpose of fire protection

under Permit No. G-2828 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 5, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.11 cubic foot per second; and shall be limited to maintaining the fire suppression system and to periods of actual fire emergency

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 19, T. 4 N., R. 27 E., W. M. Well located 450 feet South and 2530 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

T. 4 N., R. 27 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
