CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **CARL INGRAM**

of Box 636, Bandon, , State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed branch, also known as Spring Creek

a tributary of Coquille River for the purpose of irrigation of 5.0 acres

under Permit No. 16363 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 6, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.44 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, Township 28 South, Range 14 West, W. M. Diversion points located 550 feet South and 690 feet West; 575 feet South and 225 feet West, both from the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 20, T. 28 S., *

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-tenth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.75 acre foot for each acre irrigated in any 30 day period and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 6 acre feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 17

3.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 20
T. 28 S., R. 14 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered March 7, 1961, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Carl Ingram and recorded at page 27332, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
